Privacy Act Statement

Information on individuals is used by employees of the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development Estates program who need to know the information in order to respond to the program requirements. The personal information will be retained for 30 years after the last administrative action and then records are transferred to Library and Archives Canada (LAC) to be stored as archival records.
